1. SCOPE OF WORK:

(a) Details hydro-geological study of core and buffer zone as per the GEC guidelines notified on 24.09.2020 amendment in 29.03.2023 & further amendment thereof. and obtaining renewal of NOC, (350 M³/day) from CGWA, GOI for Extraction /use of ground water for drinking and domestic purpose in respect of Thakurani Iron & Mn. Mines (1546.55Ha) of M/s OMDC Ltd as per Guidelines to regulate and control Ground Water Extraction in India.

(b) All required compliance of CGWA/Competent Authority for obtaining NOC (350M³/day) should be carried out by the agency.(c) After renewal of the NOC. The agency has to submit to OMDC all the uploaded data sets & documents and final approvals document both hard and soft copies in CD/pen drive.

(2) Assistance to be provided by OMDC:

(i) The OMDC will provide existing approved Mining Plan to the Agency/consultant.

(ii) OMDC will provide certificates and undertakings as per the requirement.

(iii) All other statutory payment, if any, will be made by The OMDC. Ltd.

(iv) OMDC will provide the existing NOC copy of (350 M³/day).

(v) OMDC will pay any statutory fees if required.

(3) CONTRACT PERIOD:

(i) The work shall be fully completed within three (03) Months from the date of issue of work order.

(ii) The time period may be extended with sufficient justification to the satisfaction of the Management (OMDC) that the delay is beyond the control of the consultant/agency.

(4) DATE OF COMMENCEMENT OF JOB:

The Agency should commence the related Jobs immediately after issuance of the Work Order.

(5) EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

Each Tender must be accompanied with the non interest bearing Earnest money Deposit of Rs.9,000/- (Rupees Nine Thousand) only in shape of Bank Draft/Bank Guarantee/Pay Order drawn on any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank in favour of "The Orissa Minerals Development Co.

(6) SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD):

The EMD converted to Security Deposit which will be released within **60(Sixty)** days after completion of the job. OMDC will have the absolute right to adjust security deposit in case the agency defaults in carrying out the job as per the scope of work.

(7) ELIGIBILITY CONDITION:

A bidder shall qualify technically subject to fulfillment of following condition. The bidder must submit the documentary evidence along with the technical bid in support of the following:-

- (i) The bidder should have experience in preparation of hydro-geological report & approval of NOC- Ground water from CGWA of One Mining project during last 05 years ending 31.03.2026. Copy of work order/Lol/Agreement along with NOC from CGWA to be enclosed. Work order value should not be less than **Rs. 2.25 Lakhs.**
- (ii) The Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs. 9000/-** (Rupees Nine thousand) only in shape of DD/Pay Order/Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled / Nationalized Bank except Co-operative and Gramin Bank(s) payable to "The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited" at Barbil to be enclosed with the Technical Bid.
- (iii) Submission of Proof of payment made to OMDC towards cost of tender Document of Rs.708/-(Rupees seven hundred eight only) to be enclosed with the Technical Bid.
- (iv) Agency should submit self attested copy of PAN card, & GST Registration Number.
- (v) The average annual financial turn-over (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25) during the last three years ending 31.03.2025 should be at least **Rs. 1,35,000/-** (Rupees One Lakh Thirty Five Thousand Only) as per the annual report (audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant in India.

Notes for Financial Criteria:

In order to be qualified, a Bidder needs to fulfill the Financial Criteria as mentioned above. For the purpose of this, stand alone financial statements shall be considered.

Documents to be submitted: For meeting the Financial Criteria, the following documents are to be submitted:

a) Copies of Audited stand alone financial statements for the 03 (three) Financial Years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25.

b) Certificate from Chartered Accountant certifying the turn over for the 03 (three) Financial Years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25.

c) Turnover Certificate and audited Profit & Loss Account certified by a Chartered Accountant (CA) shall contain the Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN)

and the membership number of the CA. On online verification, the UDIN must display the name of the Firm name / PAN no. of the bidder as applicable.

(vi) Copy of Partnership Deed in case of a Partnership firm, Memorandum & Articles of Associations in case of a Limited Company, Proprietorship Certificate in case of proprietorship firm to be submitted.

(vii) A declaration is to be submitted that the bidder has carefully read all Tender terms & Conditions of the tender document. (Attached in Annexure-I).

(viii) An undertaking, in Agency's Letter Head is required regarding that the bidder is not blacklisted/debarred by any PSU & OMDC at any point of time. (Attached in Annexure-II).

Note:-

1. Submission of any forged document will attract legal action including the rejection of Tender or cancellation of contract at the risk and the cost of the agency, if awarded.
2. All documents along with the tender shall be self-attested by the authorized signatory of the bidder with official seal.

8. EVALUATION OF THE BIDS:

- i. Bidders, who will fulfill all the requisite conditions of Eligibility Condition clause of Chapter-II of this document, will be considered as technically qualified and considered for opening the Price Bid.
- (ii) The bidders are required to quote their price both in figures & words in the PRICE BID format enclosed as **Annexure-III** of the Tender Schedule (Part-II). The bidders are required to quote their price (Exclusive of applicable GST). Price Bids of the bidders will be opened in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives on a scheduled date and time which will be intimated in advance through Telephone/Letter/E-mail (s).
- (iii) **The L-1 bidder will be evaluated on the basis of lowest quoted rate in the Price Bid at Part-II, Annexure-III exclusive of applicable GST.** In case of low quoted price the agency has to submit Bank Guarantee equal to the differential amount between the estimated cost and quoted rate.
- (iv) In case there is any discrepancy between figures and words, then the amount quoted in words will be considered for evaluation.
- (v) The bidders may be asked for submission of short fall documents during evaluation of technical bids. These documents shall not be related to submission of EMD and cost of tender document. These documents may be allowed to be submitted within a specific time period.

9. AWARD OF CONTRACT:

- (i) OMDC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
- (ii) OMDC reserves the right to reject any part or whole of the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever. For such cancellation the tenderer shall not be entitled to claim of any cost, charges, expenses incidental to or incurred by him through or in connection with the preparation and submission, without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- (iii) OMDC also reserves the right not to accept the lowest offer (L-1)
- (iv) Award of contract shall be made at the absolute discretion of OMDC.
- (v) The time period may be extended with sufficient justification to the satisfaction of the Management (OMDC) that the delay is beyond the control of the consultant/agency.

- (vi) The agency, shall be required to execute an agreement within the time specified in the Letter of Intent / LOI.

10. SUBMISSION OF BILLS:

The bills in triplicate mentioning Work Order No. & Date etc. shall be submitted to the Dy. Manager (G & E), Geology & Planning Department who shall forward the same to Finance Department for consideration of payment. Payment will be released after obtaining approval from the Business Head.

11. PAYMENT TERMS:

Payment shall be made on the basis of the rate quoted in the Price Bid(Part-II). The agency(s) need to submit the details of Bank A/C, Branch, IFSC code, etc for enabling OMDC to release the payment through RTGS in the following manner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. DEFINATIONS:

a) Tenderer/Bidder: Tenderer/Bidder means an Individual, Society, Partnership Firm, Consortium or Company willing to participate by accepting terms and conditions given in the tender documents.

b) Tender: Tender means the work to be perform according to the Tender Documents (Both Technical and Commercial) submitted by the bidder for consideration of OMDC.

c) Name of the Tender: Name of the Tender means, the work; to be performed by the Bidder/Tenderer.

d) Techno-Commercial Bid: Techno-commercial Bid means documents regarding eligibility condition as stipulated in the tender documents for qualifying the bidder for consideration of the Price Bid.

e) Scheduled Rate: Scheduled Rate means the rate quoted by the tenderer in the prescribed format for various activities to be performed by the tenderer.

f) Price Bid: Price Bid means the document containing the scheduled rate to be considered for the purpose of evaluation and award of contract.

g) Contractor/Agency: Contractor means the Individual, person, society, firm or company whose tender has been accepted by the OMDC.

h) OMDC: OMDC means "The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited". A company incorporated in India and having its Head Office at Plot No-271, Ground Floor, Bidyut Marg, Shastri Nagar, Unit-IV, Bhubaneswar, Odisha-751001

i) Employer: Employer means "The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited".

j) Competent Authority: Competent Authority means Managing Director (MD) or any designated officer by the MD.

k) Taxes: Taxes means Income Tax, Surcharge, Service Tax, CESS Tax, value Added Tax, Entry Tax, and any Other Tax, Levy, Fees, CESS as imposed by the Government from Time to Time.

2. TENDER SUBMISSION:

The bidder shall submit the Tender in 02 (two) parts consisting of Part-I (Techno-Commercial) and Part-II (Price Bid) each in separate envelopes duly sealed and super scribed with the Tender Notice Number. The instruments of Earnest Money Deposit & Cost of Tender document are to be put in a separate envelope duly sealed and super scribed with the word "Earnest.

All the 3 (three) envelopes containing Part I, Part - II, "Earnest Money & Cost of Tender" shall be put in a 4th (fourth) envelope duly sealed, super scribed with Tender Notice No., Name of the job, date of opening of Technical Bid and addressed to Business Head, The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited, Thakurani, Dist-Keonjhar, Odisha.(Pin-758035).

Note: Tender not submitted with Cost of tender Paper, EMD, Part - I and Part - II in separate covers properly sealed as prescribed above shall be considered as invalid and will be rejected. Tenders can be submitted either by post, courier service or deposited in the Tender box in the office of the Business Head, The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited, Thakurani, Dist-Keonjhar, Odisha, (Pin-758035).

However, OMDC shall not be responsible for delay occurring in postal/ courier services resulting in non-submission of the bid documents within time. Tenders not received in prescribed format will be liable to be summarily rejected. Conditional Bids not adhering to the Tendered terms and conditions are liable to be rejected.

Tenders will be received up to 3.00 P.M. on 08.07.2024 and will be opened on the same day at 3.30 P.M. in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives. The bidders will be intimated about the date & time of the price bid opening in advance through Letter/E-Mail/Telephone.

The tender document shall have to be signed by the bidder in each page and the terms & conditions must not be altered failing which the tender will be rejected. In case of any difference in rate between figure and in words, amount mentioned in words will be final for evaluation of contract. Any tender containing clerical or arithmetical mistakes may be rejected. Any request from the bidder in respect of additions, alterations, modifications etc of either terms or conditions or rates of its tender after opening of the tender may lead to . rejection of the tender.

Note: The Tender submitted by the Tenderer, who has been debarred by any PSU, will not be eligible to participate in the tender.

3. OPENING OF TENDER:

(i) The Part-I, Techno Commercial Bid shall be opened in the presence of the bidders or their accredited representative at 3.30 P.M on 26.06.2026 in the Dept. of the Finance of the Company.

(ii) Part-II i.e. Price Bid of the Tenderers, whose Techno-Commercial bids were found acceptable, shall be opened on a fixed date & time, which will be intimated to the bidders separately after

opening and finalization of technical bids. In this respect, the decision of the company shall be final and binding on the Tenderers.

4. VALIDITY:

The validity of the offer shall be for 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the date of opening of the Techno-commercial bid.

5. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

In case the successful bidder declines to take up the work, OMDC right to terminate the contract and forfeit the earnest reserves the money/security deposit of the agency. In such eventuality, the agency will have no claim for the cost he/they might have incurred for taking up the work and the cost of the work he/they have incurred by that time and the work may be rescinded.

6. RISK PURCHASE:

In the event of failure to fulfill the contract terms and execution of work as per letter of Intent/work order/agreement, OMDC reserves the right to make the contractual obligation carried out by alternative arrangements and OMDC shall recover from the contractor any additional cost involved therein.

7. PRICE ESCALATION:

The rate accepted shall be firm and fixed during the tenure of contract and no price escalation shall be allowed.

8. STATUTORY COMPLIANCE:

Agency will have to carry out the necessary statutory compliance required for the job.

9. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:

If in the event, either or both the parties to the contract is/are prevented from discharging its/their obligation(s) under the contract by reason of one or more of the events such as arrest(s), restraint(s) by Government of people, blockade(s), revolution(s), insurrection(s), mobilization(s), strike(s), civil commotion(s), riot(s), accident(s), Act(s) of God or other natural calamities or on account of any other act(s) beyond the control of the parties to the contract, the time of delivery shall be extended by the period equal to the period of delay/constraints occasioned by one or more of the aforesaid Force Majeure conditions. However in the event of customer invoking the Force Majeure condition(s), OMDC shall have the option to cancel the contract for reasons of any or all of the Force Majeure conditions notified by the customer without being able to pay any compensation whatsoever to the contractor.

On the occurrence of any of the above Force Majeure conditions, the party concerned shall notify the other party in writing of such occurrence (s) within 07 days of occurrence(s) stating therein -

(i) The date of occurrence(s) of Force Majeure disability.

(ii) The nature of such Force Majeure disability along with a certificate from the appropriate Statutory Authority and / or Chamber of Commerce of the concerned state certifying the fact of the Force Majeure condition during the relevant period.

10. DAMAGE TO OMDC PROPERTIES:
